## OUTCOME: This project incorporates:

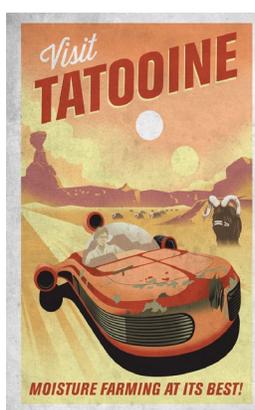

## **PRE-PRODUCTION # 1:**

### **Create or find some images for your poster**

1. Determine what destination you would like to work on. Think about a good location that is ripe for visuals
2. Look for images that would help create your vision of the poster.
3. Once you have your images, move on

## **PRE-PRODUCTION # 2:**

### **Create three thumbnail sketch ideas of your travel poster (1.0 pts)**

1. Once you've picked your destination, Create a minimum of three solid thumbnail sketches for your poster. Keep in mind that most designer create many more.
2. Make sure they're in pencil and show lights and darks
3. Once you have your thumbnails finished, see Mr. Juul to discuss your ideas and sign off

## **PRODUCTION # 3:**

### **Create A Final of your Poster idea (1.50 pts)**

1. Use Photoshop or Illustrator to create your final.
2. Illustrate / Digitally Illustrate / Use Photography / Create From Scratch
3. If you are using Photoshop, you should make an 8 ½" x 14" canvas with a 300 dpi resolution.
4. Before you flatten or finalize anything, critique your final with Mr. Juul.
5. Be prepared to make changes and take constructive criticism of your work.

## **POST PRODUCTION # 4:**

### **After You're Done... (.50 pts)**

1. Set up your poster to print on Legal Sized paper.
2. Print your final.
3. Gather your thumbnails and printed final. Make sure your name is on all of them
4. Paperclip them together and turn them all in at the same time.
5. Upload a .PNG file to Focus or turn in to the class In-Box
