

# TASK : PICTOGRAM POSTERS

Using these examples, create 2 simplified pictogram movie posters

# **PRE-PRODUCTION:** 1 Points for all completed Production Work

- Determine what films you will be working on
- Think about key, defining characteristics of each film. Characters? Events? Locations? Props?
- Sketch out three ideas **for two** pictogram movie posters. Snap a photo of your concepts and get those to me for feedback before making a final.
- The images have to be international typographic style pictograms and symbols. <u>Look at</u> <u>these examples.</u> Every image in your poster should adhere to this simplicity.

# **PRODUCTION:** 3 Points for all completed Production Work

#### PICTOGRAM POSTER – Adobe Photoshop

- 8.5"w x 11"h blank canvas.
- Resolution is 300 dpi.
- The font used for the title is Helvetica Black. The title of the film should be in capital and lower case letters
- The font used for the "A Film by" and "Starring" is Helvetica Light
- The font used for the director and stars is Helvetica Bold.
- Choose a textured paper background. Use the noise filters at your disposal. How will you match the kind of damaged / dirty look of the base images?

- Save the PSD and AI versions.
