



DESIGN CHALLENGE:

Create A Concert Poster Of Your Favorite Band

Your favorite band has chosen YOU to create a concert poster for their upcoming Florida concert date.

YOU WILL NEED TO:

- Choose your band singer. Can be from any era.
- Create 3 solid thumbnail sketch ideas in pencil that show values.
- Critique those ideas, receive feedback before doing any digital work. Have Mr. Juul sign off.
- Create a final of your poster. 8 1/2" wide x 14" high 300 dpi resolution
- Critique your work as it nears completion. Be accepting of suggestions / revisions.

TIPS:

- Use the computer to create your fonts
- If you need to scan materials, let me know and I can help you

OUTCOME:

Students get creative and create an original of artwork for their favorite band. Also explore layout and use of fonts. 3 points for thumbnails, final completed to specifications below

YOU WILL NEED TO # 1:

PRE PRODUCTION

- 1. Determine what singer / band concert you'd like to promote.
- 2. Where? When? How Much? Website? Album?

YOU WILL NEED TO # 2:

Create three thumbnail sketch ideas of your poster. Use pencil. Show values. (.50 pts)

- 1. Once you've picked your title , start to brainstorm.
- 2. Create a minimum of three thumbnail sketches. Most designers often do many more.
- 3. Show values (lights and darks)
- 4. Once you have your thumbnails finished, sign of with Mr. Juul.

YOU WILL NEED TO # 3:

Create a color layout of your poster idea in Photoshop or Illustrator

- 1. 8 1/2" x 14". (Legal Size) 300 dpi
- 2. Piece together your poster.
- 3. Once ready, make it available for a critique with Mr. Juul

YOU WILL NEED TO # 4:

Create a Final of your poster idea (1.50 pts)

- 1. Make recommended changes
- 2. Print your final on legal sized paper. 8 1/2" x 14"



YOU WILL NEED TO # 5:

POST PRODUCTION (.50 pts)

- 1. Gather your thumbnails and final. Make sure your name is on all of them
- 2. Paperclip them together and turn them all in at the same time.
- 3. Upload a digital version of your final in a .PNG format to Focus or the Class In-Box
